

**OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR RATIFICATION OF 2008 BYLAWS AMENDMENTS**

“RATIFICATION” means that you vote to adopt the October 2008 bylaws election result, and waive any alleged or actual defects or failures to abide by the requirements of the Corporations Code. Such adoption and ratification would be retroactive to October 19, 2008, the date the ADDA Board commenced operations under the 2008 Bylaws and adjusted dues to reflect its new certified union responsibilities. Ratification occurs if a majority of the members of the ADDA vote in favor of the proposed ratification below.

**BALLOT #2: PINPOINT RATIFICATION OF 2008 MEMBERSHIP DUES PROVISION**

*Old 1998 By Laws SECTION 5: “Admission Fee Dues: There shall be no admission fee. The annual dues of active members shall be \$15.00 for calendar year 1988. The annual dues of retired members shall be \$10.00 for calendar year 1988. Commencing in 1989 and in all years thereafter, the amount of dues shall be set by the Board of Directors and such dues cannot exceed the previous year by an amount greater than \$5.00. All dues shall be payable in advance of January 1st of each year. The Board of Directors shall have the power to remit or waive dues of any member or members, in whole or in part.”*

*2008 Amended ADDA By Laws Section 2.11 “Membership and Dues. Membership in the Association is limited to non-managerial Los Angeles County deputy district attorneys (Grade I through Grade IV), or such other individuals deemed appropriate by a 2/3 vote of the Board of Directors. The membership dues and method of collection shall be established by the Board, and an applicant for membership will become a member 30 days after submission of a signed payroll dues deduction form and withdrawal of funds via payroll deduction. A member in good standing is one whose dues are not more than 15 days in arrears. Only members in good standing may vote on any action.”*
